## GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

“Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.”

The Red River Classic Horse Show reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any class it deems appropriate and the Exhibitors will be notified.

The Red River Classic Horse Show reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges and/or officials if it becomes necessary. The judges' decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and the Red River Classic Horse Show accepts no responsibility for these decisions or the decisions or actions of officials.

The Red River Classic Horse Show reserves the right to refuse or accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages.

**AISLES:** Barn aisles may not be obstructed under any circumstances.

**AMATEUR CERTIFICATION:** Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. USEF Chapter 13. Certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Competition Secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation.

**ATTIRE:** All riders, drivers, and attendants shall be neatly and suitably dressed on entering the show ring.

**BICYCLES, SKATES, ETC.:** No bicycles, skates, etc. may be used anywhere in the coliseum during performances.

**CHANGE OR CANCELLATION:** Management has the right to combine, cancel or split any classes it deems appropriate. Management reserves the right to reschedule any class for the overall good of the show, exhibitors to be notified as per USEF rules.

**CHAMPIONSHIPS:** All first, second and third place winners in qualifying classes are required to enter the championship class. Exhibitors must fill out & sign the official entry form in the office for these classes. Winners in Junior Horse classes, Junior Exhibitor classes and Amateur classes are not required to show back in Open Performance Championships. They will be required to show back in a respective Championship if offered. Any Exhibitor failing to comply shall forfeit all prizes in the qualifying class. (Refer to USEF GR 809) No post entry fee for championship classes will be charged.

**CLASS ANNOUNCEMENTS:** Although every effort will be made to maintain a working P.A. system, please be aware class calls are a courtesy to the exhibitor. Show management is not responsible for an exhibitor missing a class,

**COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATES:** Proof of negative Coggins within the past 12 months of the last day of the show is required of every horse entering the show grounds. A copy of the test results must be presented to the Show Secretary upon arrival.

NO NUMBERS WILL BE ASSIGNED WITHOUT CURRENT TEST RESULTS.

ALL OUT-OF-STATE HORSES MUST HAVE HEALTH CERTIFICATES AND MUST BE DATED 30 DAYS WITHIN THE DATE OF HAULING.

**COLISEUM: HARDY MURPHY COLISEUM RULES AND REGULATIONS:** The following Rules and Regulations are to be observed by all Red River Classic visitors and facility users, and shall be enforced by City management and/or security personnel.

1. City facilities shall be utilized at user's own risk. City is not responsible for any personal injury or personal property damage on or going to/from premises.
2. Under NO CONDITIONS may hard alcohol be served or sold. Sale or distribution of food and beverage, or other commercial activities, is not permitted without the written consent of the Hardy Murphy Coliseum and the completion of written contractual agreements.
3. Under no circumstances is smoking permitted in the stall area or the Coliseum.
4. No horses will be allowed to be tied to fences nor will any individual use any fence, building or piece of

equipment belonging to HMC to create a corral or any such livestock containment device.

5. Facility users and visitors must comply with all environmental laws, rules and regulations.

**COMPETITION RINGS:** Main Show Coliseum is 270' long x 126.5' wide. Outside covered arena is 300' long x 150' wide. Footing is clay mix in all warm-up and competition and dressage arenas.

**CONDUCT:** The Horse Protection Act of 1970, Public Law 91-540 as amended will be followed. Exhibitors are cautioned as to their conduct in the ring and in the schooling areas, especially with respect to training and schooling horses. Use of all rubber or elastic devices on legs are prohibited on the show grounds before or during this show. Violators will forfeit all trophies, ribbons and premiums previously won and will be barred from any further competition, and will have absolutely no recourse against the management of this show and its officials.

**DRUGS & MEDICATION:** In compliance with the USEF Drug and Medication Rule, a \$15.00 fee will be collected on all horses entered, including equitation horses. The Drugs and Medications fee has been incorporated into the USEF Fee and will continue to be assessed per horse, per competition. This includes the \$7.00 drug fee and a \$8.00 USEF fee. The Show Committee has requested USEF to test these shows for use of forbidden substances.

**DOGS/PETS:** No dogs or other pets will be permitted on the grounds unless under leash control of the owner. No pets allowed in the arenas. Owners assume all liability for their pet animals.

**ENTRIES:** Entry and stall reservations must be accompanied with a check or money order, payable to the RED RIVER CLASSIC and mailed to Show Secretary, Kelly McFaul, 206 S. Lark Ln., Wichita, KS, 67209. All entries must be made on the official entry blank, one owner per entry blank. Every exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach and trainer or his agent must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver or handler under the age of 18, his parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf. Deadline April 12, 2010.

- Classes entered during the show require payment in full or an open check deposited with the Show Secretary. Any change in rider, driver or handler must be made in the horse show office by the conclusion of the previous performance with the new rider/driver/handler's USEF number. NO CHARGE
- POST ENTRIES: Entries not postmarked by the entry deadline, April 12, 2010, will be accepted with a post entry fee of \$25.00 per horse. There is no post entry fee for additional classes for horses entered in the show prior to the deadline. Added class entries must be made in the horse show office and will be accepted up to one hour prior to the beginning of the performance in which the class is to be held. If added classes are not paid for at the time of entry, then a signed check made payable to the show must be deposited with the show secretary.
- REFUNDS/SCRATCHES: Scratches for entries prior to APRIL 12, 2010, will receive a TOTAL REFUND of entry and stall fees. After APRIL 12, 2010, entry fees only are refundable IF ACCOMPANIED by a veterinary certificate. NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED AFTER APRIL 13, 2009. Under no circumstances will any fees be refunded after the entry closing date without a veterinary certificate.

**FEED & BEDDING:** Initial bedding will not be provided. Bedding will be available on the grounds at reasonable and competitive price. Advance orders for bedding are appreciated; contact Kelly McFaul at 316-650-2287.

**FOOD SERVICE:** A concession stand will be open on the grounds. Hours of service will be posted.

**GOLF CARTS:** Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind; including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**GYPSY HORSE DIVISION:** The Gypsy Horse section of this Horse Show is open to Registered Gypsy Horses only. Gypsy Horses shall be shown with full mane, feather and tail (exception: braiding of mane and tail is optional in English and costume classes only). Gypsy horses entered in this show are exempt from the USEF drug fee. Owners/Trainers/Handlers are exempt from the USEF membership rule.

**HIGH POINT SCORING:** Points for scoring High Point Awards will be assigned as follows:  
1st-7, 2nd-5, 3rd-4, 4th-3, 5th-2, 6th-1.

**JUDGING:** A single-judge system shall be used for all classes.

**NUMBERS:** A number will be assigned to each horse at the time the entry is received. That number will stand for the entire show and must be displayed whenever the horse is in the ring.

**OPPORTUNITY CLASSES:** Horses entered only in this section are exempt from the USEF Drug Fee. Drivers entered only in this division are exempt from the USEF membership rule. Entries are allowed to cross enter in other classes in this horse show provided the requirements are met for those classes.

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds must wear protective headgear (Exception: Trail classes). All juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty by the judge.

**PROTESTS:** As per USEF Chapter 6, Protests may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 (\$300 if made by a non-member) and received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

**PARKING:** There will be ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING in unauthorized barn areas. Parking will be allowed for loading and unloading only. Parking will be permitted in designated areas only.

There will be no payback in Jr. Exhibitor, Equitation or Dressage. Payback will be mailed within thirty (30) days of the close of the show and will be mailed to the owner.

**QUESTIONS, DISPUTES AND PROTESTS:** Protests must follow the procedures outlined in the USEF Rule VI. All protests and questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by the Red River Classic Horse Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. Disputes should be presented to the Show Manager prior to filing a formal protest under the provisions of the USEF Rule GR603.

**REGISTRATION:** Morgans shown must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Assn. Inc., or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered name and registration number, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the names of the owner(s) or leasee of record with AMHA, CMHA or BMHS. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry.

The Gypsy Horse section of this Horse Show is open to Registered Gypsy Horses only.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Every entry for competition will be under control of the Red River Classic Horse Show and the horse show management, but in no way shall Red River Classic Horse Show, and/or its owners, officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers or personnel, be responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to any horse exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged that may occur- even if the harm occurred as a result of the negligence of Red River Classic Horse Show, and/or its owners, officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers or personnel. It shall be a condition of entry that each Exhibitor expressly assumes all risk of harm (including death or destruction) to him or herself and/or his or her agent, employees, associates, children, animals, or personal property. It shall also be a condition of entry that each Exhibitor shall hold Red River Classic Horse Show and its owners, officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers and personnel; Hardy Murphy Coliseum; AMHA and USEF blameless for any loss or accident to his or her person or property, including his/her horse and equipment.

**RETURNED CHECKS:** There will be a penalty of \$50 charged if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time and must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash, in addition to the penalty. Unpaid fees will be subject to USEF rules and regulations.

**RV SPACES:** RV spaces will be available at \$20/day, with or without hookup. The horse show office will NOT handle overnight arrangements. Please make your reservations by contacting the Hardy Murphy Coliseum at 580.223.2541.

Optional Camping: Lake Murray State Park, 3310 South Lake Murray Drive #12A, Ardmore, OK 73401, 580-223-4044, 800-257-0322. This large park features Lake Murray, a 21,000 acre man-made lake that is popular for water skiing, scuba diving, and fishing. You'll also find a miniature golf course, a nature center, and an airport strip at this park. Lodging facilities are available.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All exhibitors in the horse show will be under the control and direction of the Show Management and said Management will not be responsible for loss, injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or in anyway damaged. You may report lost articles to the Show Secretary.

**SHARPS DISPOSAL:** It is the responsibility of each individual stable to properly dispose of needles, syringes and other bio-hazardous materials. Sharps containers will be placed in the barns. Please use them to dispose of these items.

**STABLING:** Stalls are permanent with full doors. Stall assignments will be posted at the show office. Stalls will be available at 9:00 am on Tuesday, April 27 at \$70.00 per stall. Stalls will not be available prior to that time. Each horse must be assigned a separate stall, except with suckling foal. Requests to be stalled with another exhibitor must be made directly to the show manager.

Stabling is assigned by the Show Manager based upon level of sponsorship, number of horses brought and stabling

issues. The Show Manager and Show Committee's decisions in regard to assignment of barn aisles and stalls are final. STALL CHART WILL BE POSTED AT THE SHOW OFFICE.

**USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT:**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

**A copy of the appropriate, current USEF membership card(s) must be sent with entries. If a copy of the card(s) does not accompany the entry or is not presented upon checking in, and cannot be verified at the show office, then a member must pay a \$30 non-member fee..**

**USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE:**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

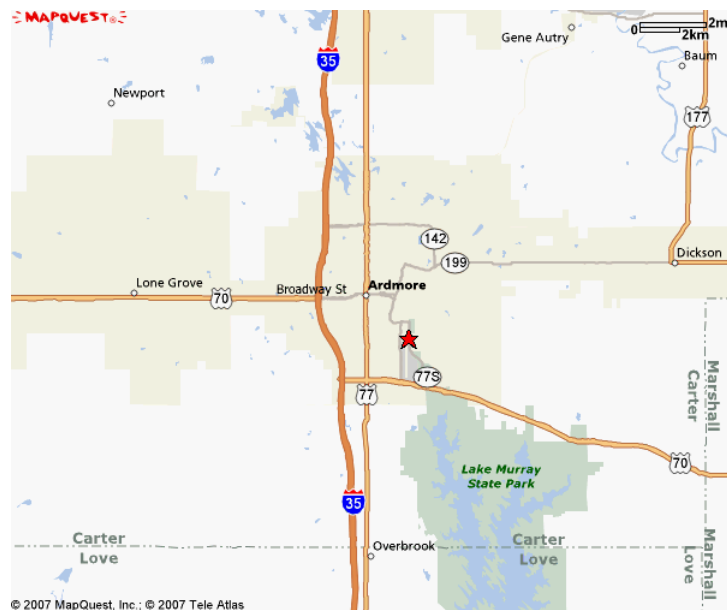
From Oklahoma City, OK or Dallas, TX
